Double Split Skyline

Public Art Advisory Committee (PAAC) member Grant Cottrell reached out to artist Dewayne Hughes, a Texas sculptor, about displaying his artwork temporarily at the corner at Park Springs Park. Mr. Hughes offered two pieces that he would allow the city to display temporarily. The PAAC selected Double Split Skyline noting a good fit with the setting and an appropriate scale. The PAAC has identified this display site for temporarily installations with a theme of “temporary contemporary” and this artwork aligns with the goal for this site.

This will be a temporary display, a minimum of one year. Mr. Hughes is asking only for the cost of transportation and lodging to install and de-install the artwork. He is not charging a lease to display his artwork. Visti Bentonville has agreed to fund the transportation, lodging and installation costs.



The second, larger one is titled, "Double Slit Skyline". It references the quantum mechanical double slit experiment that helped determine that outcome is based on perspective. I tried to recreate the concept formally by framing two adjacent perspectives of the world around us.
