A School District/Community event (Choose Love Movement Kick-Off) on the front grounds of Old High Middle School on November 9, 2019, from 10 am to 12 pm. We are requesting road closure of parts of NW 2nd Street, from NW 2nd Street, from NW “D” Street going east on NW 2nd Street for 714 feet where barricades would need to be placed on each end. This event would have an estimated 500 attendees in front of the school with large canopies located on the front lawn and concerns of pedestrian overflow onto NW 2nd Street. The marching band from BWHS consist of 200 members performing in front of school from the roadway (NW 2nd) due to not being able to fit them on the sidewalk or lawn area. I have met with Lt.
