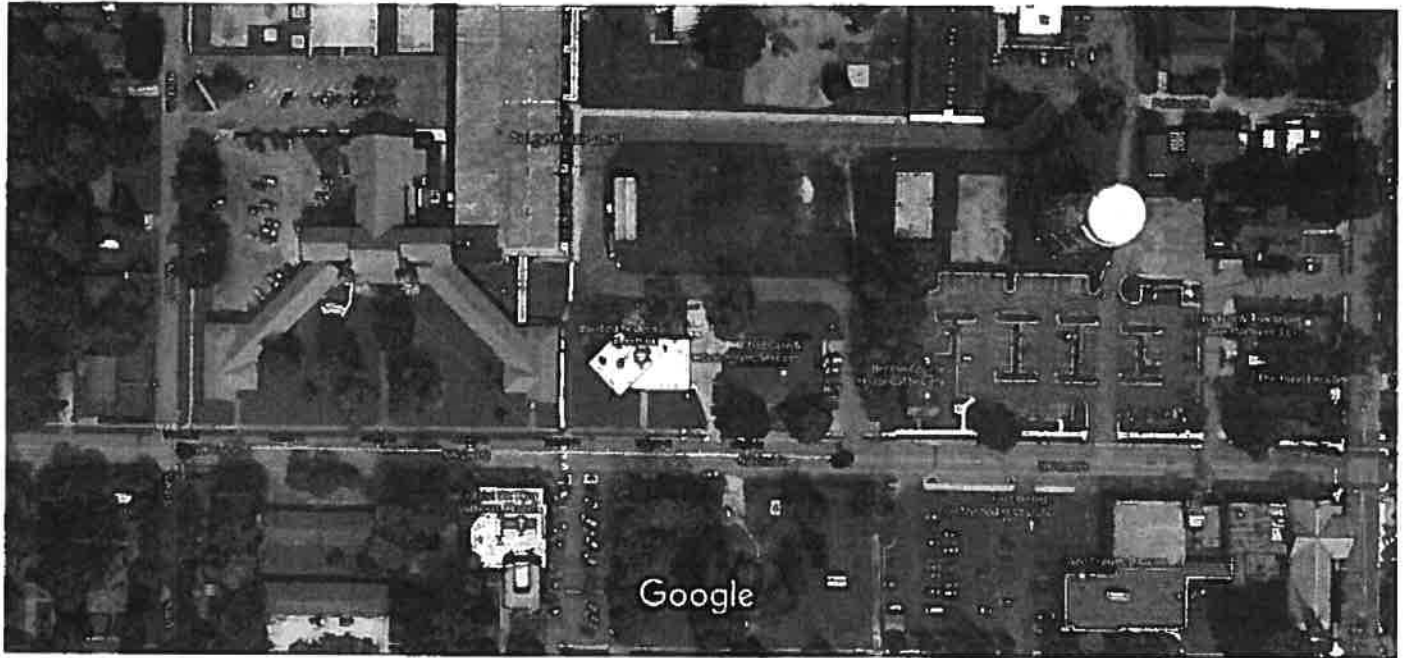

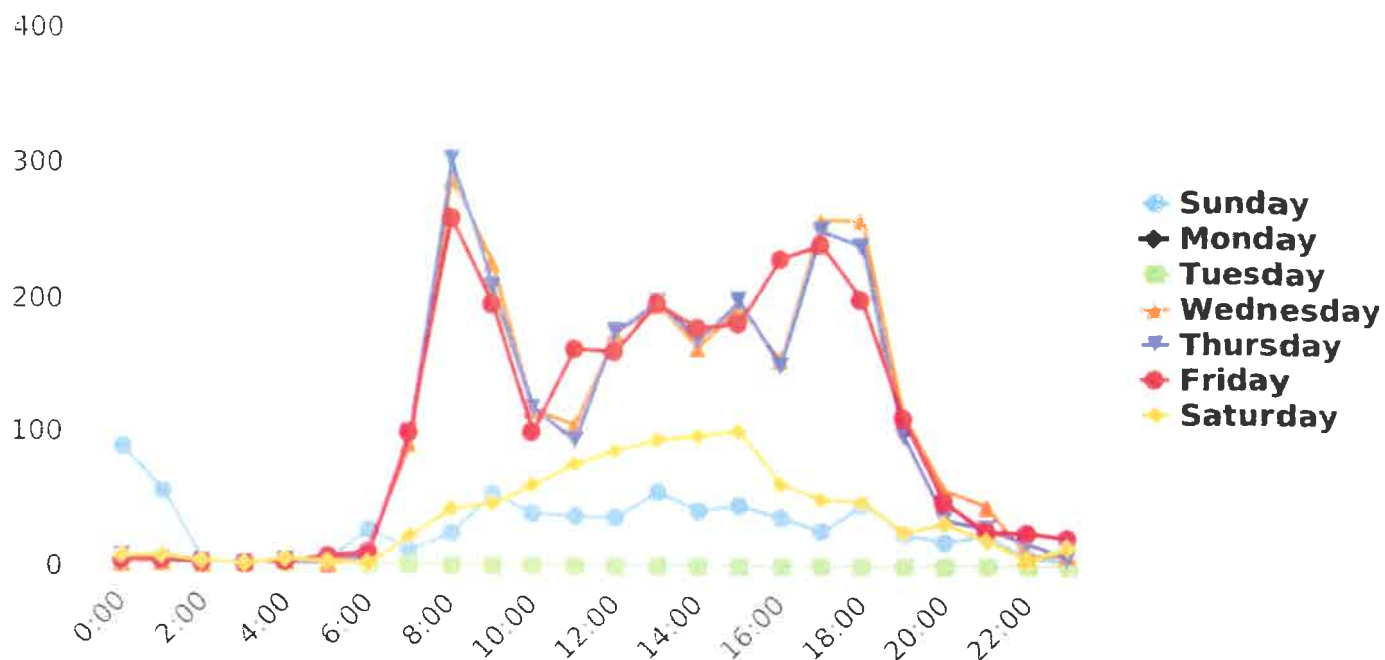

Average Volume by Time by Direction

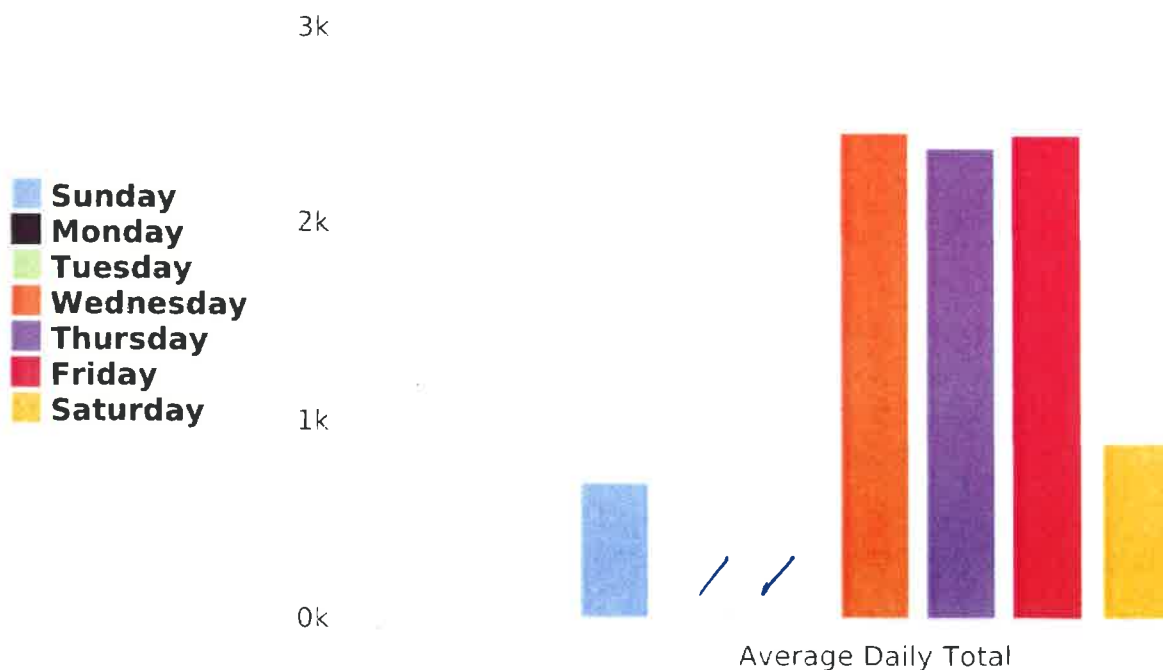

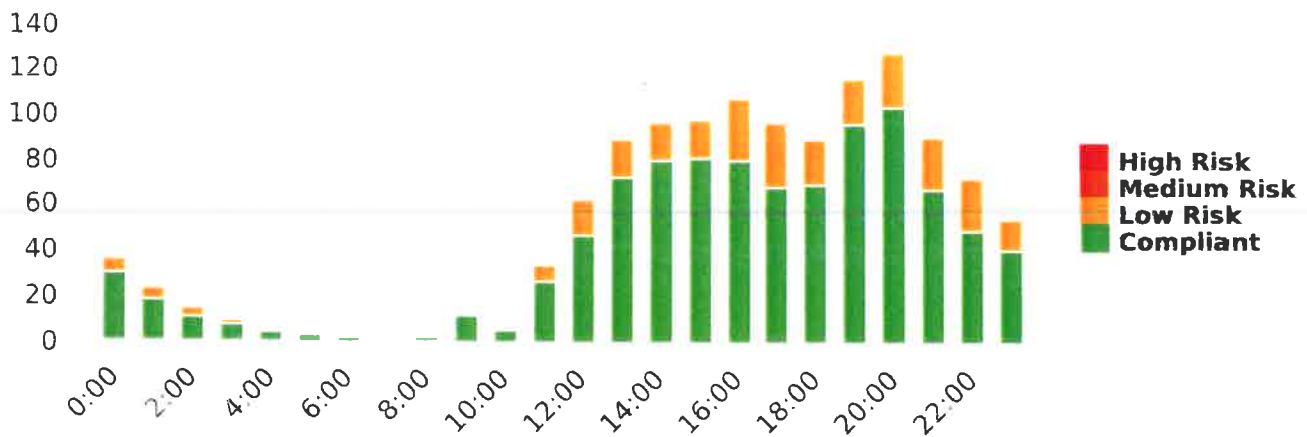

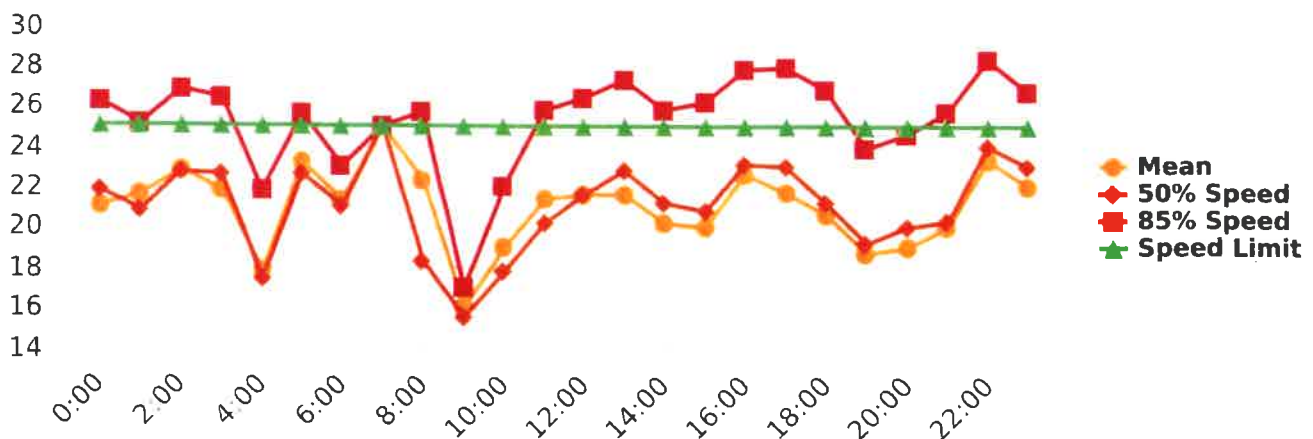
Compliance % by Hour
