MINUTES

Chief Jon Simpson called the meeting of the Traffic Safety & Signage Committee to order. He introduced Lt. Luke Rosebaugh. He is taking Lt. Michael Martin's position as the new Operations Lieutenant. Lt. Martin has retired.

I. OLD BUSINESS/TABLED ITEMS:

Asking for road closures on September 4 – 5, 2021 for 10th Annual TriFest for MS event. Road closures needed (partially) are: John DeShields, "J" Street, Tiger Blvd. and McCollum. All course maps are the same as 2020. *See maps and emails attached*

April Action: Erin Edminister appeared for the meeting via Zoom regarding TriFest event. The Committee brought up many concerns. They are: 1) Duration of the event; 2) Location of the event; 3) Police presence needed at the event; 4) Closure of streets that could adversely affect local residents in this area, including Legacy Village and a hospice house; 5) Managing the traffic; and, 6) This race has become more labor intensive and harder to manage over the last few years. Because of these concerns listed, and that the event is not scheduled until September, there was a motion and second by Dennis Birge and Tony Davis, respectively, to table this matter until May. During the next month, Ms. Edminister is to look at other alternatives and bring that back to the next meeting, if not before. Motion approved.

New route maps attached.

May Action: Ruth Sawkins appeared before the Committee and showed the maps of the new route they came up with. The Committee asked if the gas station at the corner, the Waterside Apartments and the Boys and Girls Club had been notified about race and closures. If they had not, Ms. Sawkins said they would notify them. Through conversation with the police department, it was determined that they will need six to nine officers to help with traffic. Motion by David Wright to approve the new route, on the condition that all the entities mentioned above were notified of the event. Brent Boydston gave a second. No other comments. Motion passed.

April Action: *Mr. Hill's requests were tabled to the May 3rd meeting.. David Mills made a motion to table this matter until the May 3, 2021 meeting to get traffic counts and see what we actually need to do in this area. Tony Davis gave a second to the motion. Motion passed.*
New Traffic Counts attached.

May Action: Mr. Hill notified the committee that he could not make the meeting today. David Mills said Mr. Hill wants a Watch for Children Sign, but he feels the Pedestrian Ahead sign is sufficient. David will take care of trimming the tree so that the sign is fully visible. He will not change the signage. Lt. Luke Rosebaugh will have his officers patrol through the area to keep a watch on any speeding. David Mills also took speed counts through the area, and it does not meet the 32 mph speed criteria to take any other traffic calming action. David Mills made a Motion to deny this request, based on the information above. Dennis Birge made a 2nd to the motion. Motion passed.

May Action: David Mills reported that he had put up proper speed limit signs and proper signage in this area. He also took traffic speeds and the average was 26.3 mph. He said this does not meet criteria to put in a 3-way stop. Lt. Rosebaugh said he would have his officers patrol this area more frequently to keep speeding down. David Mills made a Motion to deny any further traffic calming measures for this request. Dennis Birge seconded the Motion. Motion passed.

Mrs. Robinson will not be at the meeting. She is 82 years old, does not have email, and has some issues getting around due to a previous broken leg and hip. She has attached details to her application. Mrs. Robinson sold some of her back yard to a neighbor who lives at 1808 SE Lawrence. That neighbor has taken a lot she owns at 1911 SE Clark Street with the portion Mrs. Robinson sold her and now holds events or parties of some type that many people come to. The people that come to the events park on SE Clark side of Mrs. Robinson's house where her bedroom is located. It disturbs her so that she can't rest with all the coming and going. Mrs. Robinson would rather they park in front of 1808 SE Lawrence where the neighbor lives. In addition, she would like to have a "No Parking" sign on the side of the street where her bedroom is located. Mrs. Robinson states that if she had known what her neighbors were going to do with that property, she would not have sold it to them.

May Action: Mrs. Robinson did not appear due to not having a computer. This request was discussed. Lt. Rosebaugh will contact Mrs. Robinson and get more information from her as to when the incidents are happening and talk to her about what we can do, as well as contact her neighbor. Basically, it was noted that we would 1) Monitor this area, 2) Enforce any violations found, and 3) Communicate with Mrs. Robinson and her neighbor. With the addition of Lochmoor Phase 3 and Edgar Estates, it has been observed that there is (1) fast traffic (above limits), (2) lack of posted limits, and (3) increased construction/general traffic throughout Lochmoor Club Phase I (namely long run/convenience roads Edinburgh Ave and Blairemont Rd). The roads have become a dangerous "cut through" that would normally travel Bright Road-Gator-SW "H" Street. Requesting traffic calming services in the form of (1) additional posted speed limit/children signs, and three-way stop signs and/or (2) the installation of speed bumps/humps, and/or (3) temp/perm speed awareness detection equipment as deemed possible by the City.

May Action: Mr. Stringfellow attended the meeting and the committee discussed his concerns. David Mills made a motion to table until the June meeting so he could get traffic counts and speeds in this area, and update any signage that is needed. In the meantime, the police will exercise more presence in this area for speeders. Dennis Birge seconded the motion. This will be put on the June agenda. Motion approved.

Brittany Road is the mail throughway for two (2) neighborhoods. As a parent of two young boys, I am concerned for their safety since many cars do not obey the posted speed limits. I believe two main problems are causing this:

1) The link between the two neighborhoods rolls over a hill. This causes people to come over the hill much too fast.

2) This road is a main throughway/alternative route for Greenhouse Road traffic. This causes construction and commercial traffic to remain high and in attentive of existing speed signs.

Request/Recommendation: Speed bumps, digital speed tracking signs, police patrols, additional/more visible signage.

May Action: David Mills made a motion to table this matter to the June meeting so he could obtain speed and traffic counts through the area. Dennis Birge seconded. Motion passed. This will be put on the June agenda.

There was discussion about determining the speed for a street, and possible resetting the speed limit. Striping the street was also mentioned. Mr. Mills is going to take some traffic counts and speeds this next month, and if anything needs further attention, he will bring it before the Committee. No formal action taken.

I have 2 small dogs that bark when she has people in her yard.

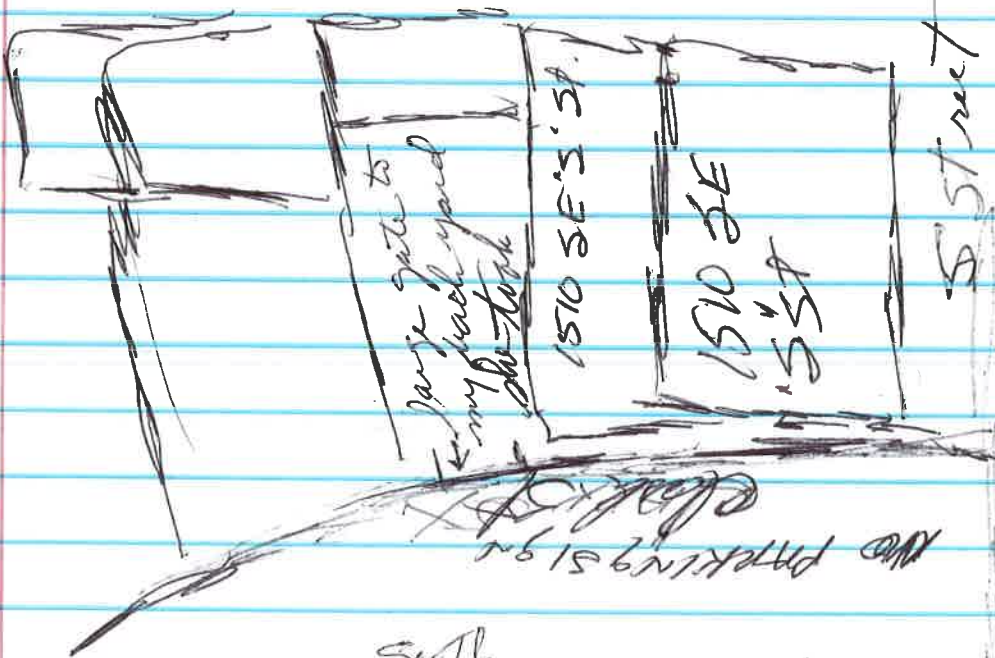
I am asking you to please put up a small sign that is for no parking from 5th St. to the beginning of her property (backyard). The front of her house is on Lawrence St so people could park there.

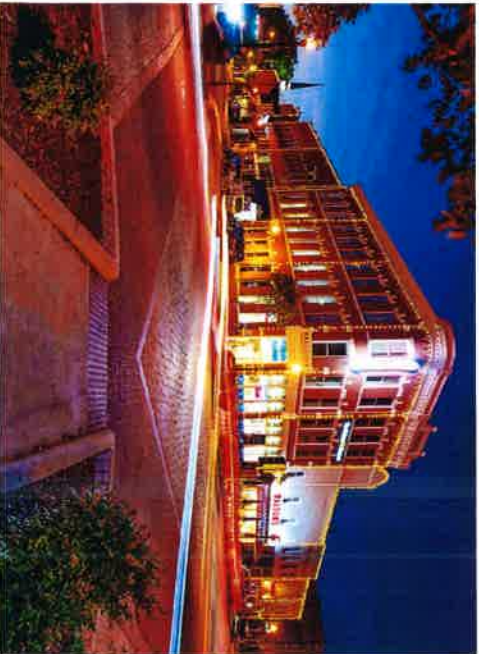

PROBLEM/REQUEST OVERVIEW

With the recent additions and construction involved with Lochmoor Phase 3 and Edgar Estates, it has been observed on several occasions that there is

- Excessively fast traffic (above limits) and;
- lack of posted limits/speed notifications and;
- increased construction/general traffic throughout Lochmoor Club Phase 1 (namely the long run/convenience roads Edinburgh Ave and Blairemont Rd).



As a result, the neighborhood roads have become an extremely dangerous “cut through” to traffic that would normally travel Bright Rd. ↔ Gator ↔ SW H Street. Accordingly, we respectfully request of the Request Traffic Calming services in the form of (1) additional posted speed limit/children signs, and (2) three way stop signs and/or (2) the install of speed bumps/humps, and/or (3) temp/perm speed awareness/detection equipment as deemed possible by the City.

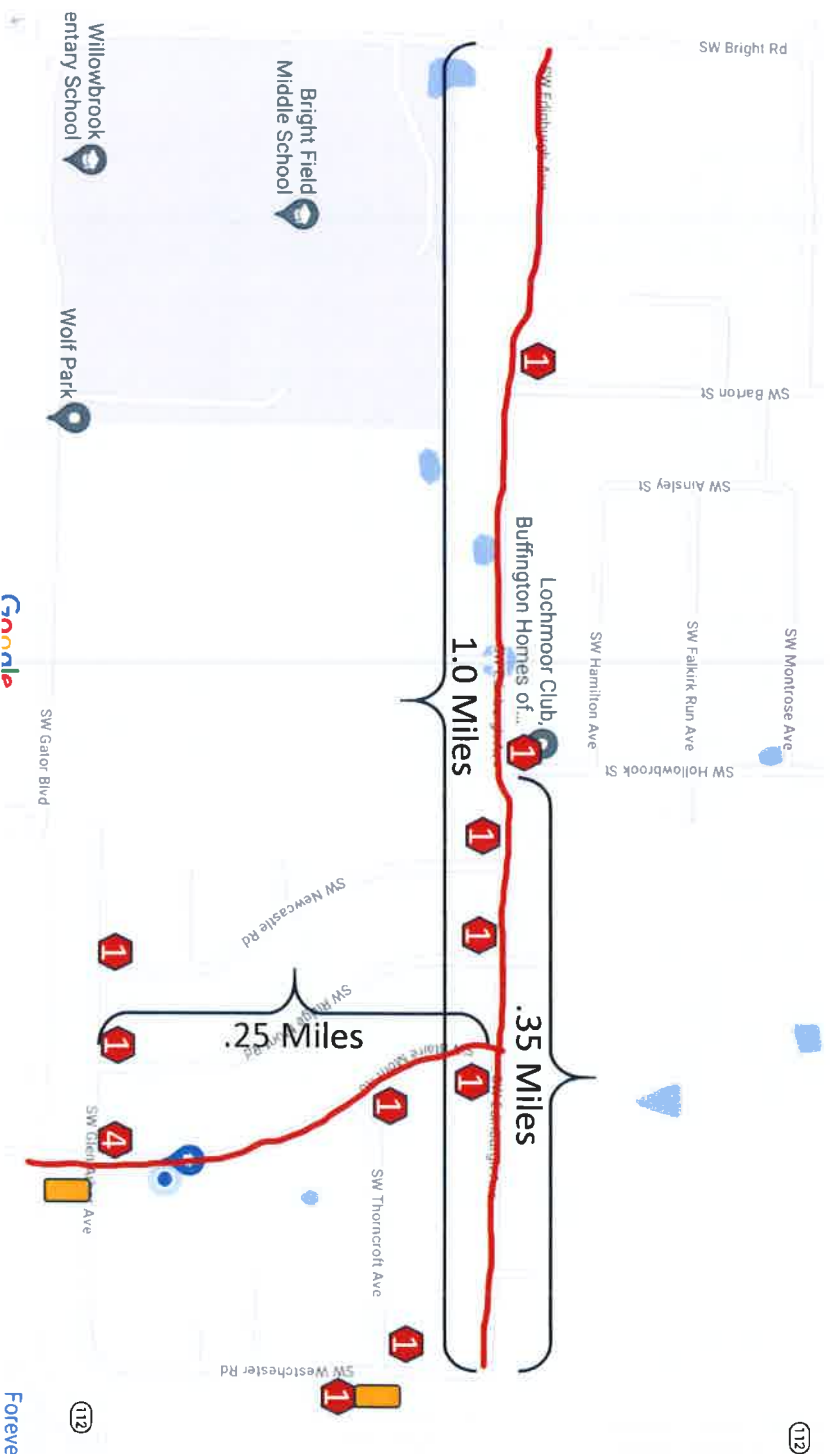
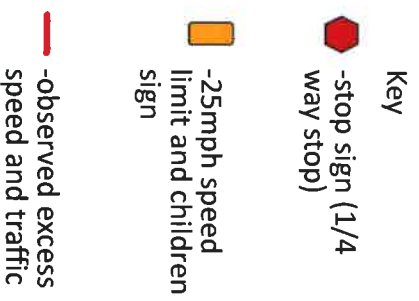
LOCATION OVERVIEW

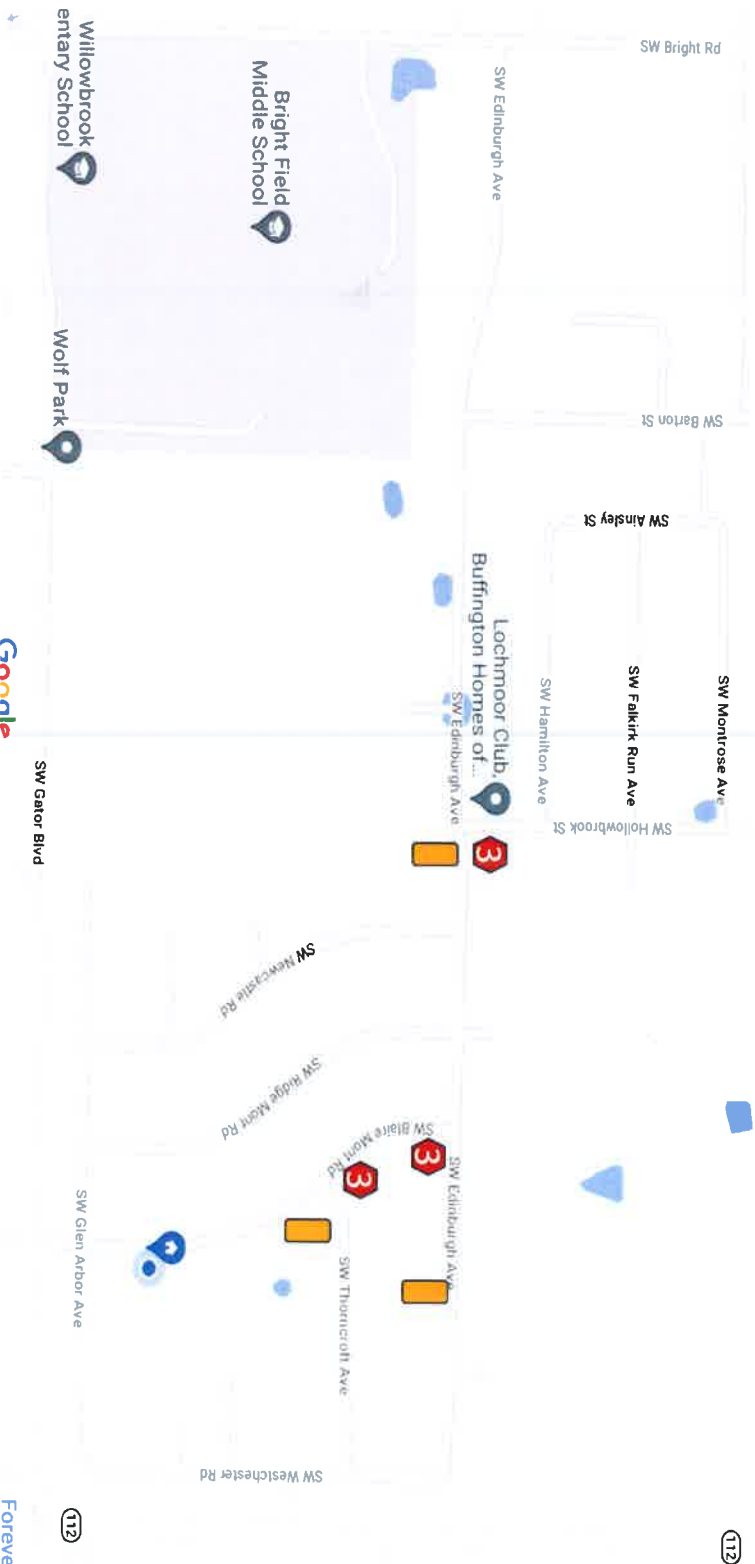

CLOSING



NEIGHBORHOOD SAFETY

Excessive speed by passenger and construction trucks/crews is causing significant safety and noise concerns within the neighborhood. Children are no longer allowed to safely traverse neighborhood streets and sidewalks to access common areas and other homes. Bike riding and jogging has become almost insufferable and without significant bodily risk. What was developed for phase 1 when it was just phase 1 is no longer supporting the increased traffic and excessive speed. We cannot wait for a tragedy to remediate this problem!

CALL TO ACTION

Over the last 2 years, traffic in Lochmoor Club Phase 1 has increased (2-3X), yet no upgrades have been made to the current Traffic Calming System. Changes in current signage, additional signage and speed notification/reduction elements need to be added to alter driver behavior to maintain the safety of the neighborhood.
