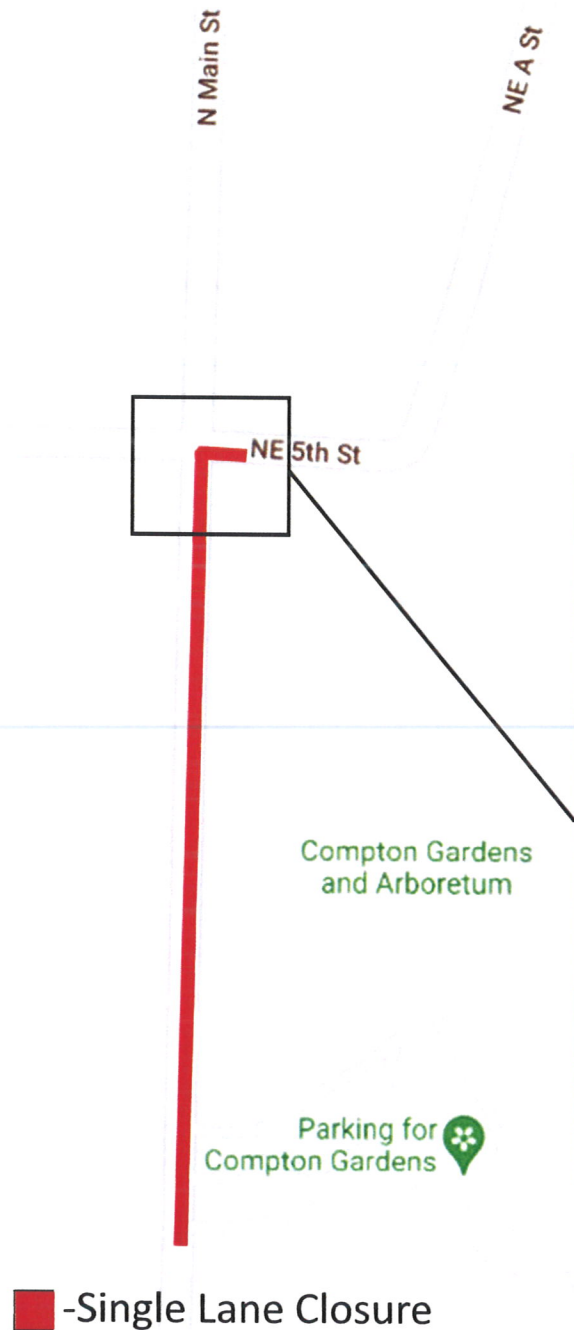
Courses leaving town:

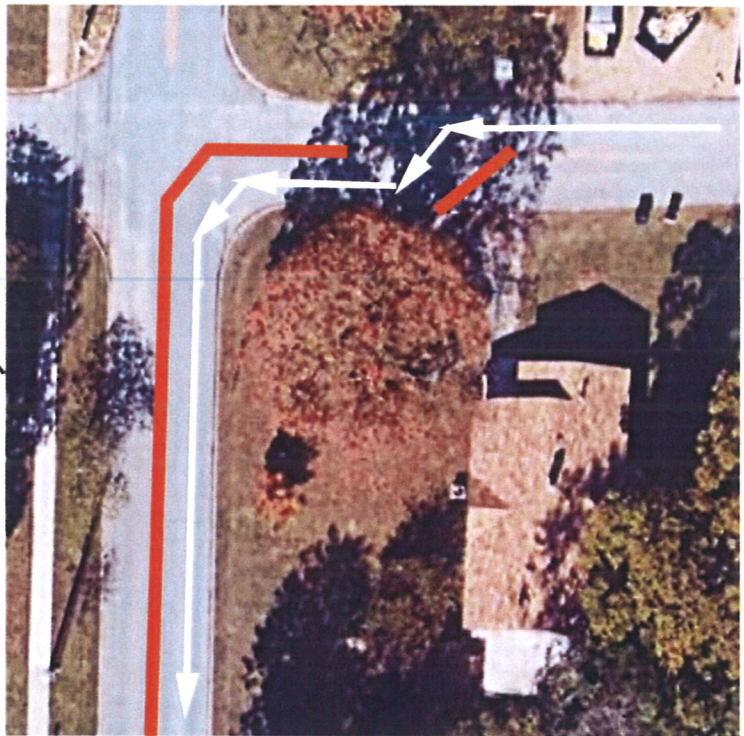
100 and 50 mile courses

Request for Temporary Street Closure

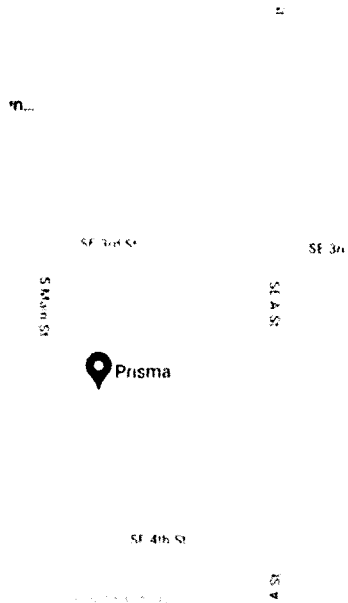
The Bentonville Public Library (BPL) and the Bentonville Library Foundation with their event partner, the Ozark Outdoor Foundation are hosting an event on the property north of the BPL on Saturday, October 23rd from 3:00pm-6:00pm. The event will be for kids & families similar in design to the OZ Kids Bike & Book Festival that we co-hosted on July 3.

This event will include a short bike race for kids from ages 3-11 that will begin around 3:30pm and end at 5:00pm. The race will be timed and managed in small groups based on the age of the rider. We anticipate that approximately 300 kids will participate in the race portion of the event. We further anticipate that the race will take approximately 10 minutes for each group to complete.

To maximize safety of the event venue and the race, we jointly request street closures at the following locations during the noted times:

- SE 4th Street, from S Main to SE A Street (runs through north lawn of Bentonville Public Library) from 1:30 until 7:00pm.
- From SE 4th to SE A Street north to SE 3rd, SE 3rd from SE A to S Main, S Main from SE 3rd to SE 4th Street, from 3:00pm until 5:30pm

In addition to the presence of race marshal volunteers along the race course, the hosts will be responsible for safety measures along the race-course such as bales of hay, orange cones and fencing at the start and finish area.

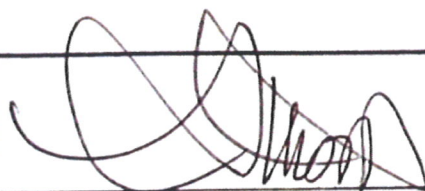
