The Lockmoor Club POA would like to have stop signs installed on SW Edinburgh (both directions) at SW Ridgemont Road. There is currently a stub street opposite Ridgemont, so adding two stop signs on SW Edinburgh at this location makes sense. The traffic and speed on SW Edinburgh has been a concern for Lochmoor Club residents. Adding stop signs at this location will help to slow the traffic. Currently, there is no stop from the beginning of Edinburgh at Bright Road, and Edinburgh turns right at SW Westchester. This long stretch encourages speeding. A stop will help, at least a bit.

After review of the area and discussion by the committee, a four way stop will be placed at SW Edinburgh & SW Ridgemont. Since the subdivision has decorative post and street signs, they will be purchased and installed at the POA's expense. David Mills will supervise and inspect the installation. Motion made by David Mills to approve, seconded by Chief Shastid. Upon voice vote, voting was unanimous.
