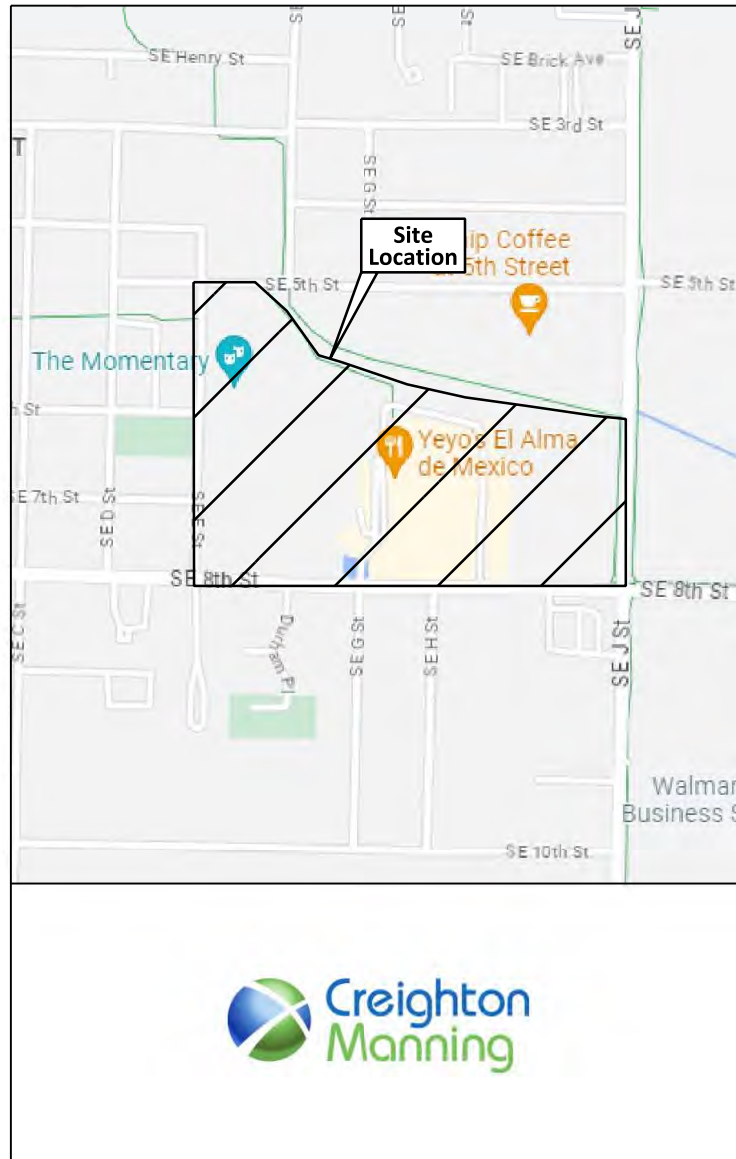

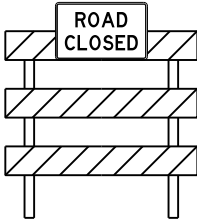

FORMAT is an art and music festival taking place on September 22 - 24 on the grounds of the Momentary and the surrounding area. We will be utilizing The Momentary's existing stage and lawn spaces. Plan for road closures is centered around safety and crowd management as well as preventing patrons from parking in the surrounding neighborhoods. We would like to close SE E Street from SE 5th Street to SE 8th Street, as well as the south lane of SE 5th street between SE E Street to SE F Street. Any residents living within the street closures will receive a vehicle credential to access their personal driveways. SE 8th Street will remain open and 8th Street Market will be incorporated into the festival footprint. We would also like to propose "soft closures" of neighborhood streets surrounding the Momentary to prevent unwanted parking or increased traffic. These streets will technically remain open; however, we'd like to place a barrel with signage advising "No Event Parking, Local Traffic Only" at intersections where we anticipate people might try to park or cut thru. Our preferred street closure times are as follows: from 8am on Sept 20 until 8am on Sept 25 for SE E Street and from 12:01am on September 22nd until 8am on September 25th for the south lane on SE 5th Street. We will be utilizing the Momentary Parking Structure for Platinum ticket holders, staff and vendors only. Patrons will be able to reserve offsite parking secured by FORMAT Festival at the Melvin Ford Lot and the South Home Office Lot (located at 702 SW 8th St, Bentonville, AR 72716), as well as being encouraged to walk, bike, ride share, or take a festival shuttle from Lowell or Fayetteville. We are also requesting use of the 8th Street Market City Lot from Sept 20th at 8am until September 25th at 8am. Traffic and signage plans are attached.

Wear the Blue 5k is part of Honor Fest. The run will be July 13, 2023 and will begin at 7am from the Silver Tree located in the Tear Drop one-way driveway in Crystal Bridges. The course heads easterly on Museum Way towards J St. The runners will enter the southern crosswalk of the roundabout, crossing J St. and entering John DeSheilds Trail. The runners will cross several parking lot entries before crossing NE Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway to enter Memorial Park Fitness Trail. Runners will then head south on the trail and follow it as it circumnavigates Memorial Park. At the junction of Memorial Park Fitness Trail and John DeSheilds Trail, runners will take a left turn onto John Desheilds Trail to return to Crystal Bridges. Crossing back over NE Martin Luter King Jr. Parkway, runners will run back to the J St. roundabout and cross J St. via the north crosswalk, entering Museum Way. Runners will first be required to cross NE John Deshields BLVD at the J St. roundabout to then go west on the northern crosswalk to enter Museum Way. Runners will enter the finishing section of the 5k.

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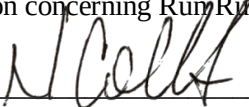

Major crossings include: J St. (east to west, then west to east) and NE Martin Luther King Jr. BLVD (east to west and west to east). Police officers are suggested as traffic flow monitoring will be required for J St, NE John DeShields, and NE Martin Luther King Jr. Signage prior to the event would allow for locals potentially affected by traffic flow to plan accordingly for the morning of July 13th. Amount of runners are unknown but loosely estimated to be between 25 and 125.

If needed, the neighborhoods affected that Thursday morning will be notified.
