Saturday **May 25th, 2024** starts early with two courses:

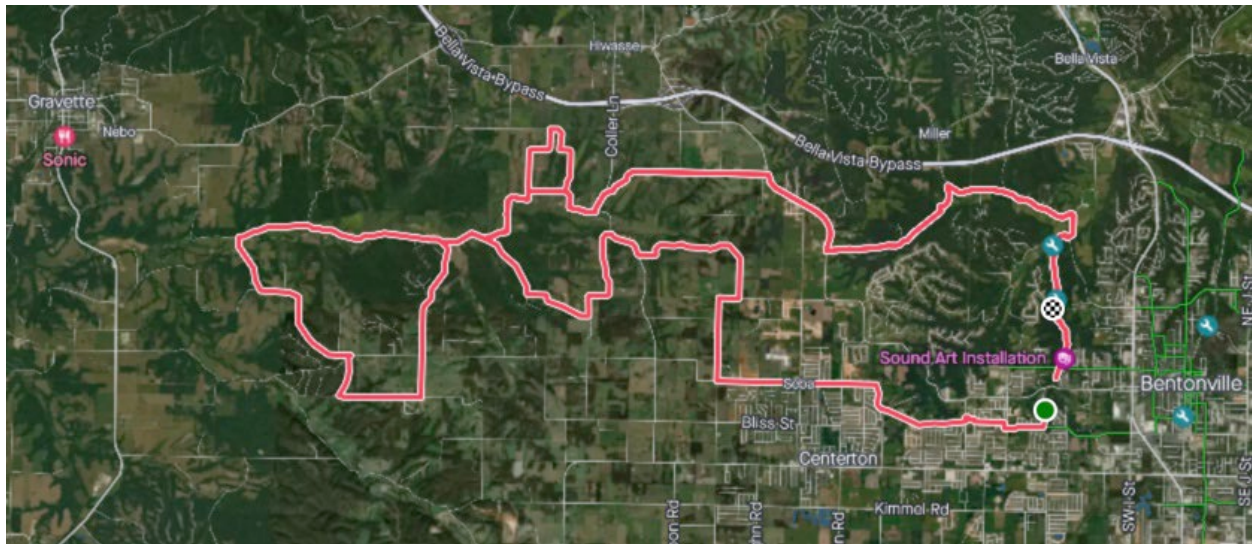

Proposed Hard closure 1.

SE C St from SE 8th St and SE 10th St

This is for the event start and festival area. In order to, maximize rider safety and experience.

This closure is proposed from Friday Sept 6th at 16:00 for set up Road could be re-open after set up complete. (Although not ideal)

Then Closure would resume on Saturday Sept 7th at 06:00 and remain until 18:30 or last rider arrival whichever is first. Road could then reopen. (Although not ideal.)

Closure would Resume again Sunday Sept 8th at 06:00 and remain until 19:00 or until all break down has been completed, whichever is first. It is anticipated the road could return to normal usage by 17:30.

Proposed Hard closure 2

NE A Street between Price Coffee Rd and 1901 NE A St
Bentonville, AR 72712.

This is intended to maximize rider safety for the timed finish portion of the event.

It is understood that limited access would have to be granted for the residences that have zero alternate access route.

It would be ideal to have this closure take effect at 05:00 on Sept 7th and remain in effect until 16:00 Sept 8th. It could be possible to have the road reopen at 16:30 on Sept 7th and resume at 06:00 Sept 8th remaining in effect until 16:30.

This is intended to maximize rider safety coming into ride finish avoiding any potential head on car collision.

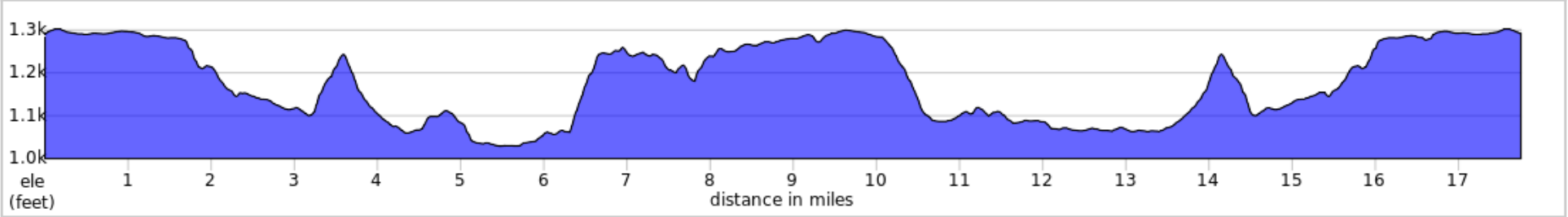
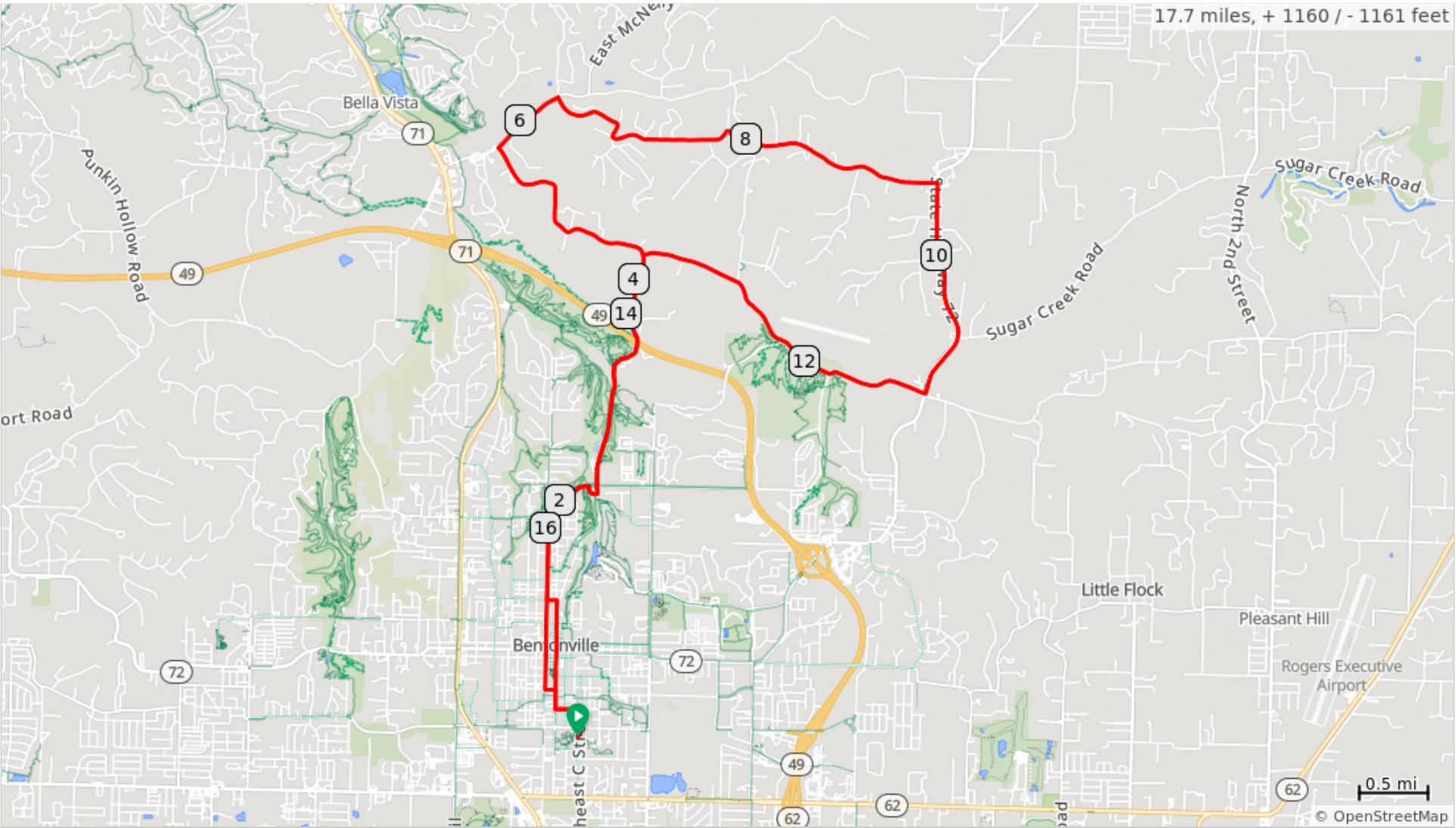
Piccolo (15 miles)
