2. **Resolution Approving a Budget Adjustment to Accept Grant Funds and Donations for the Library** **Resolution**

Resolution approving a budget adjustment for Bentonville Public Library to accept a grant award from the Illinois River Watershed Partnership, in the amount of \$15,000.00, and donations from the Bentonville Library Foundation, in the amount of \$370,531.00. A budget adjustment is needed.

3. **Resolution Approving a Budget Adjustment to Reallocate Funds for the Purchase of Library Furniture** **Resolution**

Resolution approving a budget adjustment for Bentonville Public Library to reallocate funds for the purchase of furnishings needed for the expansion, in an amount not to exceed \$1,167,500.00. A budget adjustment is needed to reallocate funds.

The City of Bentonville recommends entering into an agreement with Carroll Electric to purchase facilities and accounts at 601 SW Tater Black for \$14,254.84 and a budget adjustment to cover the costs. Approved by Utility Board 5-0. A budget adjustment is needed.
