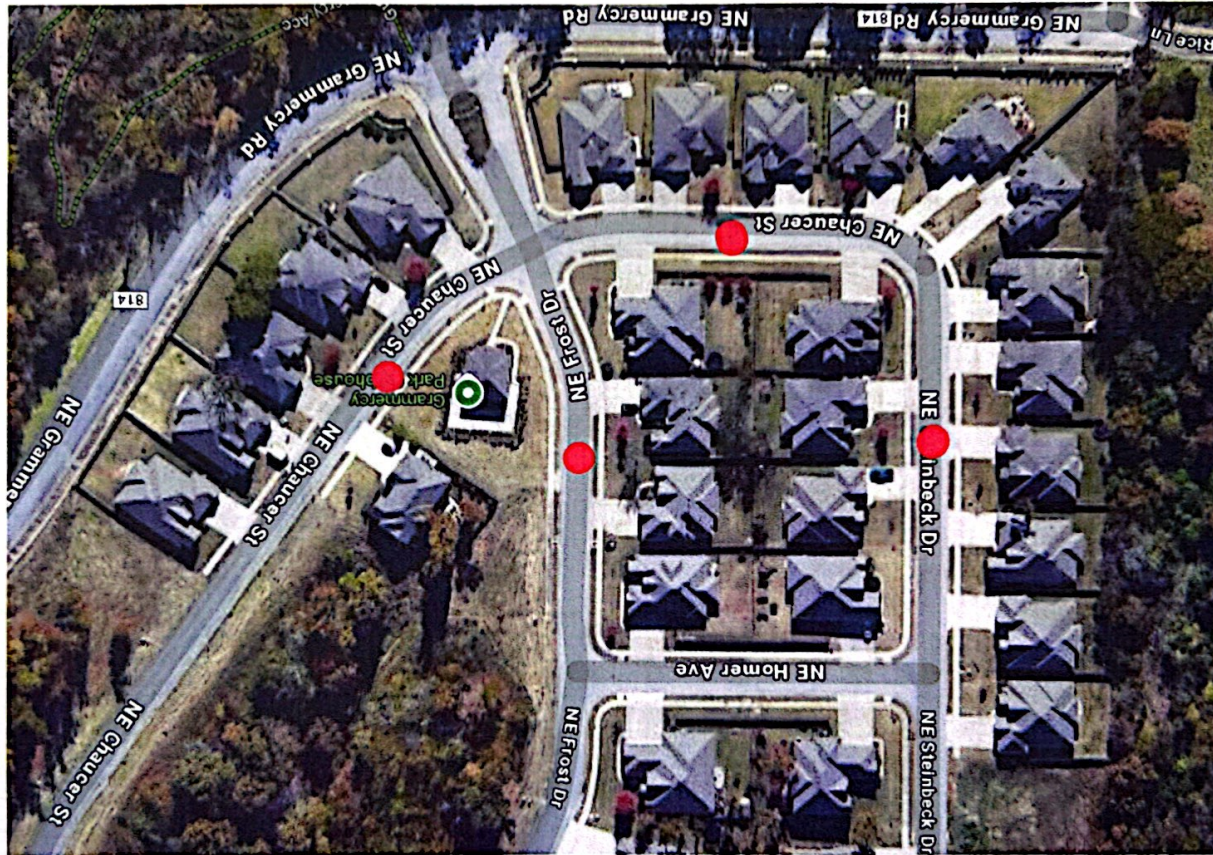

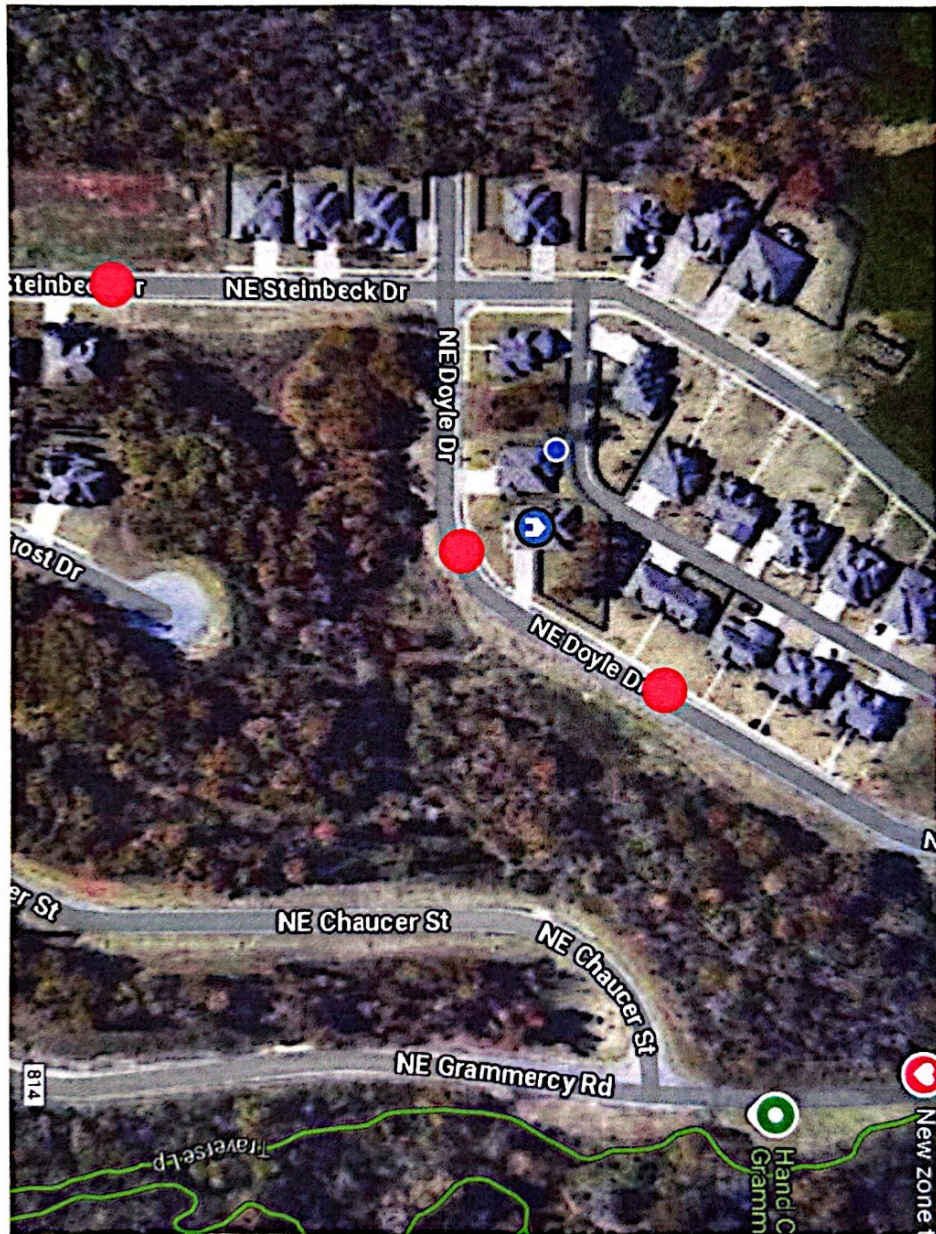

We are respectfully submitting a request for a four way stop at NW 5th and C streets. The speed limit on 5th is 25 miles an hour but that is not even remotely being observed.

We requested this in 2019 due to the fact that this is a particularly bad spot. We applaud our neighbors at B St for erecting a four way stop on Nov. 8, 2024. It has in no way impeded traffic and added only seconds to vehicle travel time and is far outweighed by the effect on safety. The C street location is even more treacherous.

Due to the topography of the land the C street intersection is the location where vehicles are increasing speed rapidly causing pedestrians and cyclists to have to hurry or run to cross safely. This is highly supported by Trailblazers who have temporarily paid for a school crossing guard which is soon to expire. The guards have expressed great concern to us, frustrated to enter the crosswalk fast enough for buses and trucks to be able to stop in time. The pedestrian, cyclist and school crossing activity at this intersection has exploded, and will continue to do so. due to higher density growth, development and a younger population in this area as well as cyclist tourism.

Calming measures are required before a tragedy occurs.

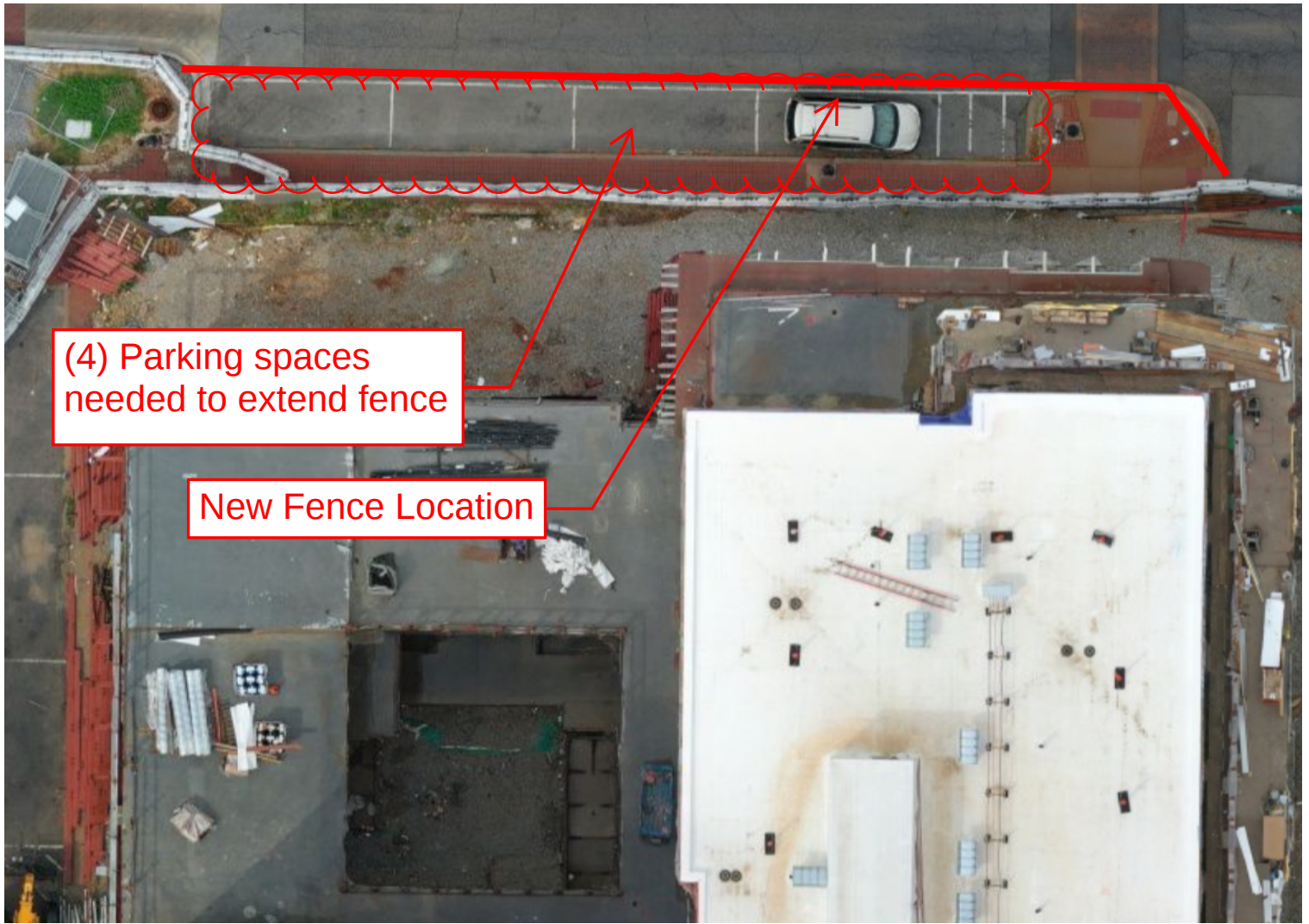

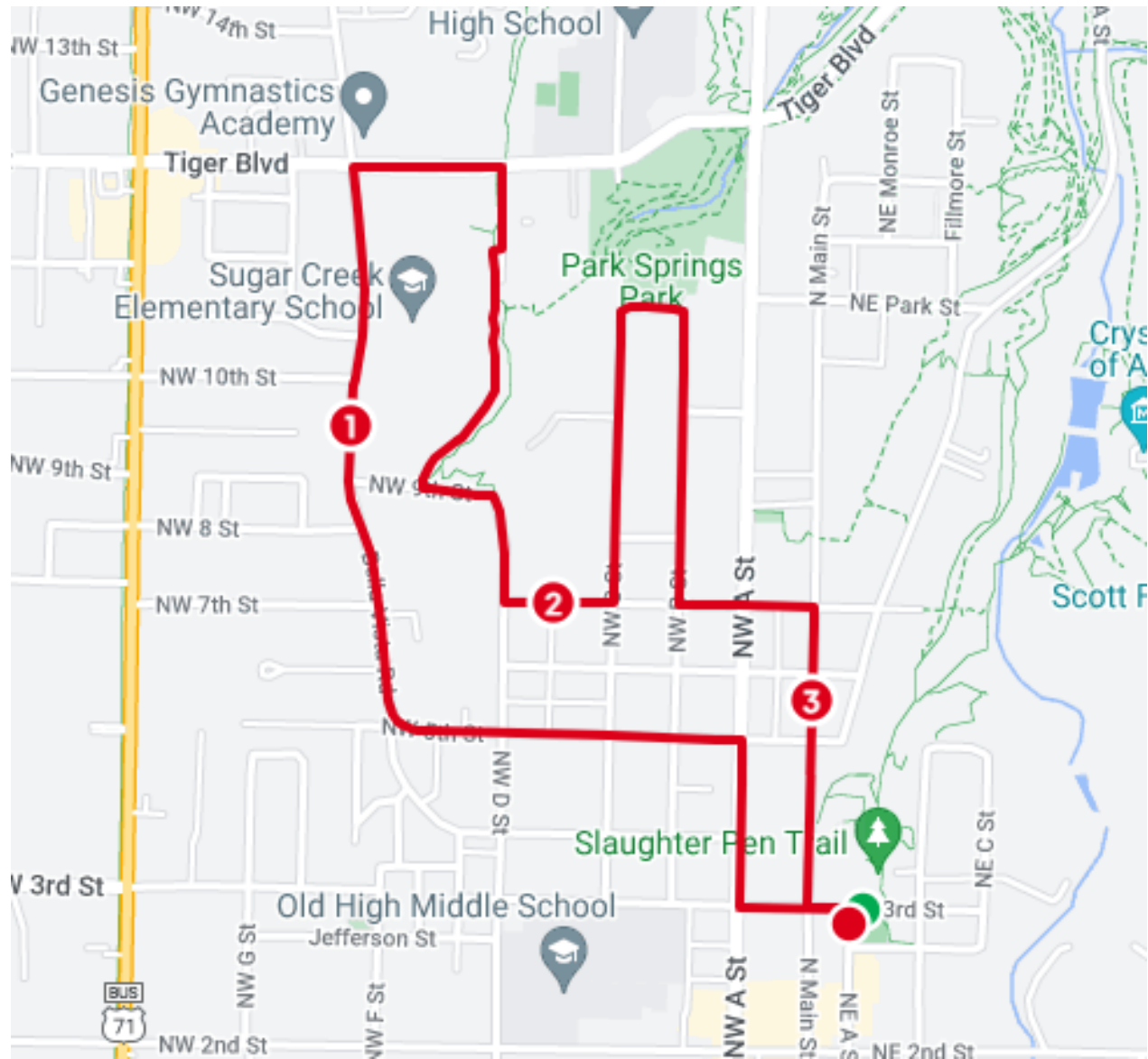
