II. Old Business

1. **Tabled at the February 25, 2025, City Council Meeting: Ordinance Adopting Water Rates for the City of Bentonville, Arkansas** **Ordinance***

Adoption of an Ordinance amending section 98-356 of the City of Bentonville Municipal Code, setting water rates for the City of Bentonville, Arkansas. Utility Board unanimously supports the proposed rates. No budget adjustment is needed.
