It is a very dangerous intersection to try and turn east onto Highway 72. This is demonstrated by the last two accidents at that intersection in the last couple of months. During rush hour, this is a very difficult intersection to navigate. I'm requesting a traffic light be installed at this intersection to keep those people using that intersection safe. I have attached a report generated by the Bentonville police department of the number of accidents that occurred at that intersection, of which 18.5% included bodily injury.

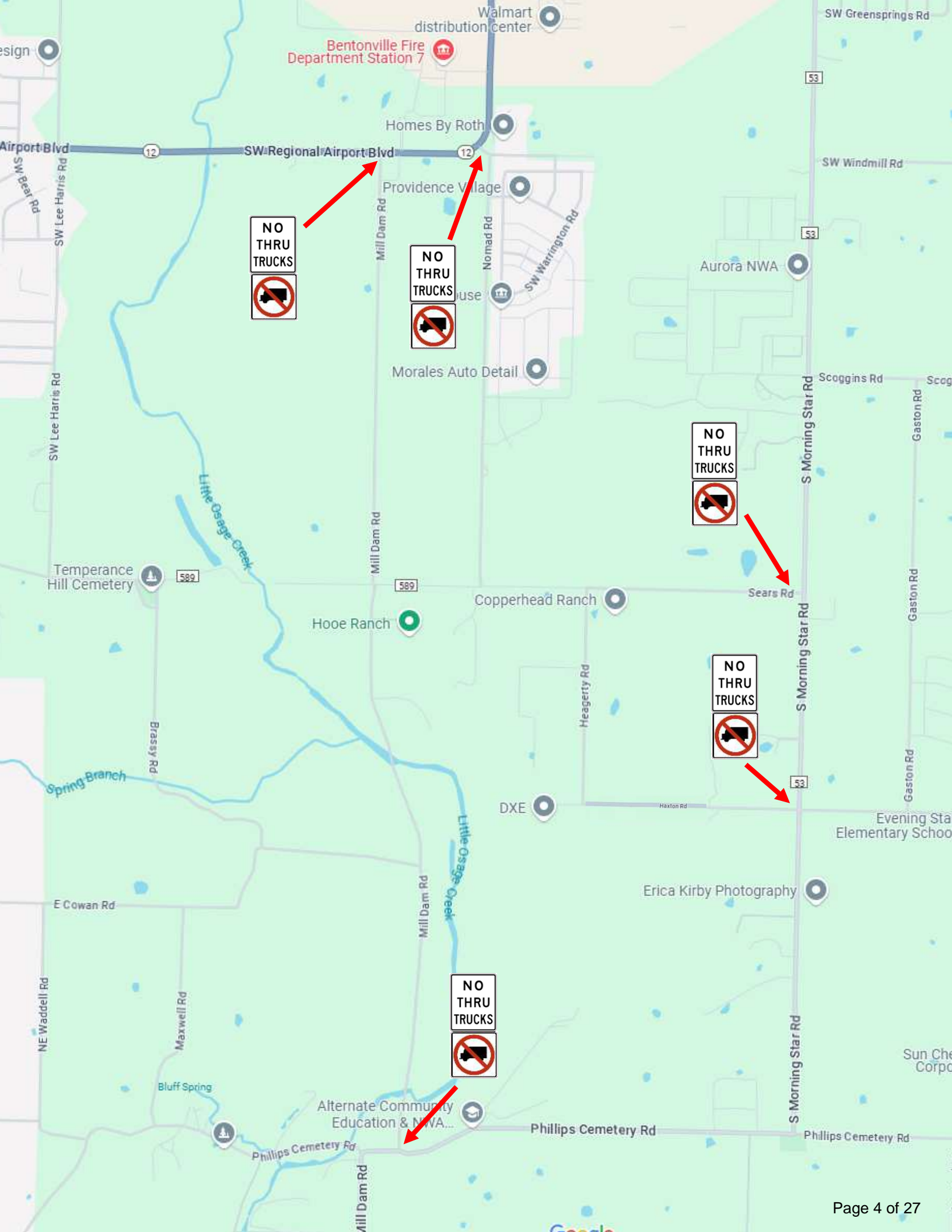

Approval from TSSC will aid in activating a street mural and crosswalk installation at the site in the image below:

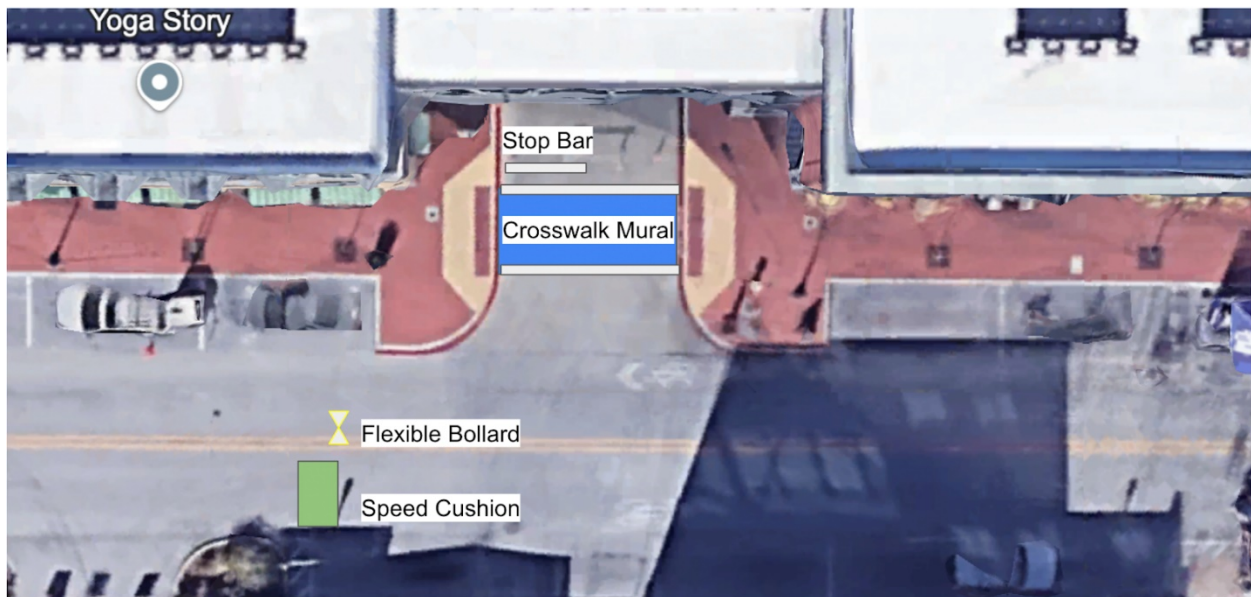


Figure 1: Site Map

This mural will serve as a transverse crosswalk at the entrance of Walmart on 2nd Street (West of Onyx Coffee Lab) and will provide pedestrians with a safer and more accessible thoroughway to businesses surrounding this entrance.

The increased safety and accessibility measures brought with the new crosswalk and flexible bollard align closely with the values in the [Bike Pedestrian Master Plan \(BPMP\)](#). Although this is already considered a “legal crosswalk” per the BPMP, the Plan and MUTCD support marking crosswalks for increased guidance and pedestrian safety (Section 3C.03). Furthermore, Section 3C.03.09 of the MUTD indicates that “where curb ramps are provided, crosswalk markings shall be located so that the curb ramps are within the extension of the crosswalk markings.” Therefore, this area is currently out of compliance with MUTCD guidance. Our proposed project would bring this space into compliance.

In addition, using paint and low-impact infrastructure interventions would allow us to communicate "expected behaviors" to road users. Section 3H.03 of the 2024 update of the MUTCD provides for "aesthetic treatments" of crosswalks.

Implementing a crosswalk in this area will make the crossing safer for pedestrians. The goal is to encourage pedestrian activity and calm traffic while promoting local culture and identity.

Moving the stop bar behind the new crosswalk will allow for safer pedestrian and automobile interaction and reduce conflict. Adding a speed cushion and a flexible bollard to the road will calm eastbound traffic without impacting cyclists using the road. Using bollards and speed cushions slows eastbound traffic, giving more time for cars exiting the driveway to react. Using a bollard and speed cushion will allow cyclists to pass by the speed cushion instead of navigating over a typical speed bump.

Based on a close review of the MUTCD guidelines, the Bentonville Bike-Pedestrian Master Plan, the Bloomberg Asphalt Art Initiative, and similar projects in MUTCD-only states, this project is feasible, and precedent exists in MUTCD-only states.

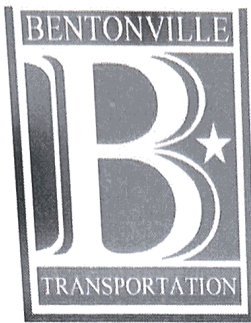

Title:	Request for Speed Bumps and No Parking Signs
Action/ Recommendation & Comments	We are requesting placement of speed bumps and "no parking" signage on the section of SE 2nd St between B Street and the Howard parking lot. This is intended to address two problems resulting from the large increase in traffic since the opening of the Howard: (1) frequent speeding and (2) parking on the perimeter of homes, including on lawn without a curb. These problems are also compounded by the construction site next to the Howard, which has brought many construction vehicles and trucks to this street. The current situation is both dangerous and unsightly.



Address/Intersection of Concern: SE 2nd Street near the Howard parking lot

Description of the Proposed Traffic Calming Request:

We are writing about two traffic problems that have arisen on SE 2nd Street since the opening of the Howard. This section of road is a dead end that terminates in a cul-de-sac and previously saw little traffic.
 Problem #1: Traffic has increased exponentially and vehicles frequently travel well above the speed limit, going in and out of the Howard parking lot. Young children live in the homes on this street and we are greatly concerned about their safety and that of pedestrians. We are asking that speed bumps be placed on the street to help enforce an appropriate residential speed limit.
 Problem #2: Vehicles frequently park on both sides of the street, in front of people's homes and on the grass (there are no curbs). They appear to be overflow from the Howard and Conifer (the problem is most acute on evenings and weekends). Some residents have placed large stones on their property to deter parking. We are requesting "no parking" signage along the street, similar to what was recently installed on B Street.

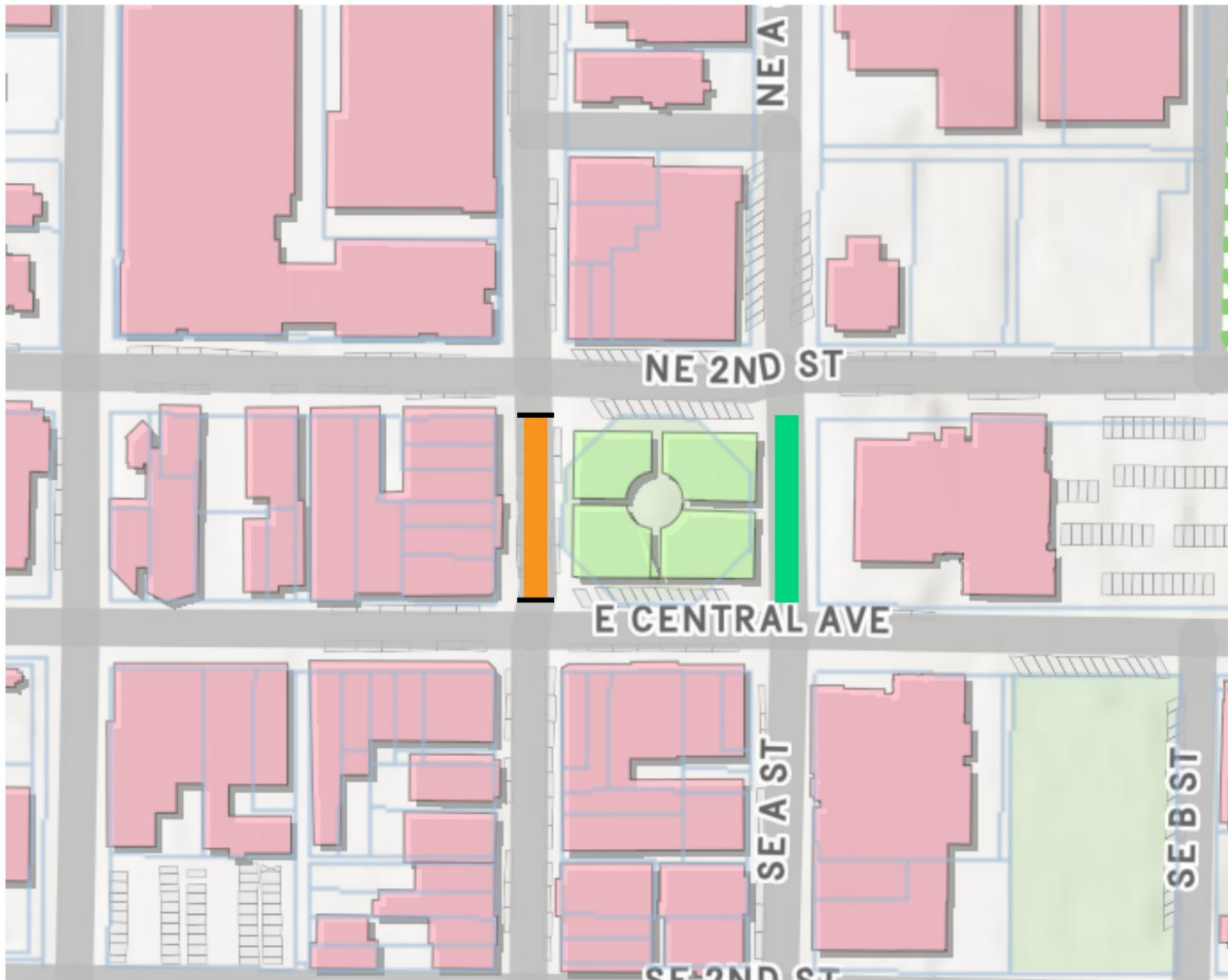

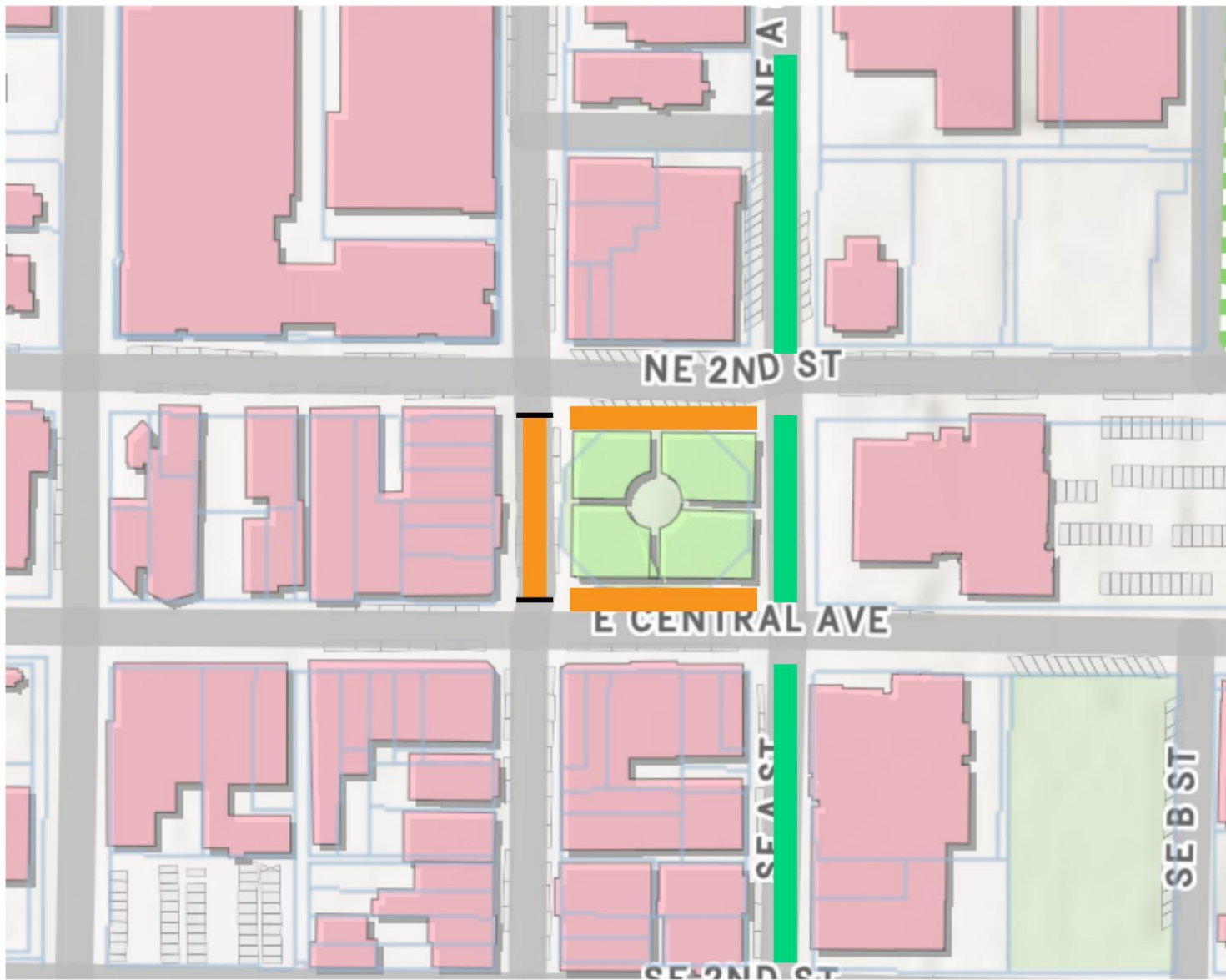

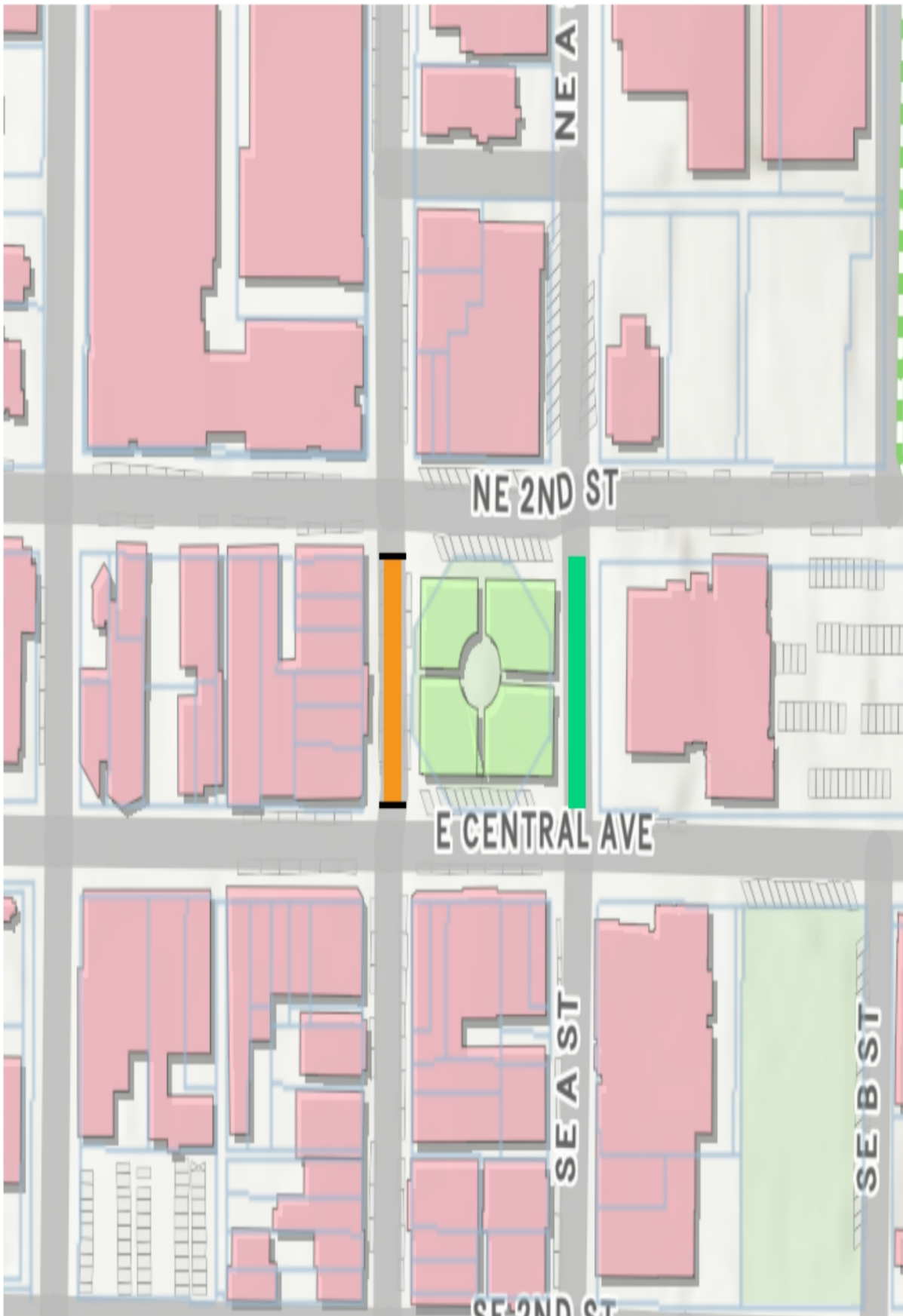
