NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF BENTONVILLE, ARKANSAS.

Section 1: That section 8.20.01 (b) of the Bentonville Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:


The Committee shall consist of the following members:

1. One Member of the City Council, who shall serve as the Chairman of the Committee;
2. The Chief of Police;
3. The City Planning Director;
4. The Public Works Director or his designated representative;
5. The Electric Department Traffic Technician;
6. The Street Department employee charged with the responsibility of erecting signage;
7. The Staff Attorney;
8. The Mayor shall be an *ex officio* member of the Committee.

Section 2: That this Ordinance is necessary to preserve the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and because of such, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of its passage and approval.

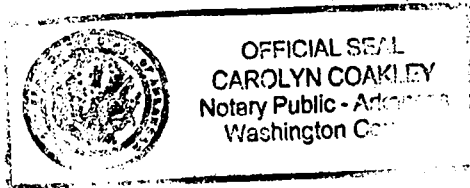

Section 1: That section 8.20.01 (b) of the Bentonville Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:

The Committee shall consist of the following members:

1. One Member of the City Council;
2. The Chief of Police or his designee;
3. The Community Development Director or his designee;
4. The City Transportation Engineer;
5. The City Street Manager;
6. The Street Sign Shop Technician;
7. The Assistant Fire Chief;
8. The Staff Attorney;
9. The Mayor shall be an ex officio member of the Committee.

Section 2: That this Ordinance is necessary to preserve the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and because of such, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of its passage and approval.

ORDINANCE NO. 99-67

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING TITLE 8, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, CHAPTER 8.20, SECTION 8.20.01 OF THE BENTONVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE, PROVIDING FOR A NEW SECTION 8.20.01, AMENDING CHAPTER 8.20, SECTIONS 8.20.02, 8.20.04 (A) AND 8.20.10 (A) AND CHAPTER 8.24, SECTION 8.24.13 OF THE BENTONVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE, TO CREATE AND PROVIDE FOR A TRAFFIC SAFETY AND SIGNAGE COMMITTEE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY BENTONVILLE, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. That Chapter 8.20, Section 8.20.01 of the Bentonville Municipal Code be and is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. That a new Chapter 8.20, Section 8.20.01 of the Bentonville Municipal Code is hereby enacted to read as follows:

Section 8.20.01 Traffic Safety and Signage Committee.

- (a) There is hereby established the Traffic Safety and Signage Committee of the City of Bentonville, Arkansas.
- (b) The Committee shall consist of the following members:
 - 1. One Member of the City Council, who shall serve as the Chairman of the Committee
 - 2. The Chief of Police
 - 3. The City Planning Director
 - 4. The Public Works Director or his designated representative
 - 5. The Mayor shall be an ex officio member of the Committee
- (c) The City Council hereby delegates its authority to designate, place and maintain traffic-control devices and regulate traffic within the City to the Traffic Safety and Signage Committee created herein.
- (d) No official signage shall be placed on any street within the City without the approval of the Traffic Safety and Signage Committee. This subsection shall not apply to the placement of temporary or short-term no parking signs by the Chief of Police as provided for in Chapter 8.24, Section 8.24.13 of the Bentonville Municipal Code.

- (c) Any action taken by the Traffic Safety and Signage Committee regarding designating, placing and maintaining traffic-control devices shall be approved by the City Council.

Section 3. That Chapter 8.20, Section 8.20.02 of the Bentonville Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:

Section 8.20.02 Installation and maintenance of traffic-control devices; conformity with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices. The Traffic Safety and Signage Committee shall place and maintain such traffic-control devices upon streets in the City as they may deem necessary to indicate and to carry out the provisions of this chapter or other ordinances of the City or to regulate, warn or guide traffic. All such traffic-control devices hereafter erected shall conform to the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

Section 4. That Chapter 8.20, Section 8.20.04 (a) of the Bentonville Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:

- (a) The Traffic Safety and Signage Committee shall designate intersections at which preferential right-of-way may be indicated by stop signs or yield signs.

Section 5. That Chapter 8.20, Section 8.20.10 (a) of the Bentonville Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:

- (a) The Traffic Safety and Signage Committee, subject to approval by the City Council may, from time to time, designate streets or portions thereof, or other areas, where the parking of vehicles is prohibited, limited or restricted on a permanent or long-term basis, and it shall be the duty of the Traffic Safety and Signage Committee to indicate such areas by appropriate markings or signs giving notice of the prohibition, limitation, or restriction. The placement of signs prohibiting, limiting or restricting parking on a temporary or short-term basis shall be handled by the Chief of Police in accordance with Title 8, Vehicles and Traffic, Chapter 8.24, Parking, Section 8.24.13 of the Bentonville Municipal Code.

Section 6. That Title 8, Vehicles and Traffic, Chapter 8.24, Parking, Section 8.24.13 of the Bentonville Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:

Signs. The Chief of Police or any other person authorized by the Mayor and Council shall cause signs to be posted in all areas where parking is limited or prohibited on a temporary or short-term basis, indicating such limitations or prohibitions. Permanent or long-term prohibitions or limitations on parking shall

be handled by the Traffic Safety and Signage Committee in accordance with Chapter 8.20 of the Bentonville Municipal Code.

Section 7. That this ordinance is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Bentonville, Arkansas. An emergency is therefore declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

ORDINANCE NO. 99-67

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING TITLE 8, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, CHAPTER 8.20, SECTION 8.20.01 OF THE BENTONVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE, PROVIDING FOR A NEW CHAPTER 8.20.01, AMENDING CHAPTER 8.20.04 (A) AND SECTION 8.20.02, 8.20.04 (A) AND 8.20.10 (A) AND CHAPTER 8.24, SECTION 8.24.13 OF THE BENTONVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE, TO CREATE AND PROVIDE FOR A TRAFFIC SAFETY AND SIGNAGE COMMITTEE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENTONVILLE, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 8.20, Section 8.20.01 of the Bentonville Municipal Code be and is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2. That a new Chapter 8.20, Section 8.20.01 of the Bentonville Municipal Code is hereby enacted to read as follows:

SECTION 8.20.01 Traffic Safety and Signage Committee

(a) There is hereby established the Traffic Safety and Signage Committee of the City of Bentonville, Arkansas.

(b) The Committee shall consist of the following members:

1. One member of the City Council, who shall serve as the Chairman of the Committee.
2. The Chief of Police
3. The City Planning Director
4. The Public Works Director or his designated representative
5. The Mayor shall be an ex officio member of the Committee

(c) The City Council hereby delegates its authority to designate, place and maintain traffic-control devices and regulate traffic within the City to the Traffic Safety and Signage Committee created herein.

(d) No official signage shall be placed on any street within the City without the approval of the Traffic Safety and Signage Committee. This subsection shall not apply to the placement of temporary or short-term no parking signs by the Chief of Police as provided for in Chapter 8.24, Section 8.24.13 of the Bentonville Municipal Code.

(e) Any action taken by the Traffic Safety and Signage Committee regarding designating, placing and maintaining traffic-control devices shall be approved by the City Council.

SECTION 3. That Chapter 8.20, Section 8.20.02 of the Bentonville Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:

SECTION 8.20.02 Installation and maintenance of traffic-control devices; conformity with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices. The Traffic Safety and Signage Committee shall place and maintain traffic-control devices upon streets in the City as they may deem necessary to indicate and carry out the provisions of this header or other ordinances of the City or to regulate, warn or guide traffic. All such traffic-control devices hereafter erected shall conform to the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

SECTION 4 That Chapter 8.20, Section 8.20.04 (a) of the Bentonville Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:

(a) The Traffic Safety and Signage Committee shall designate intersections at which preferential right-of-way may be indicated by stop signs or yield signs.

SECTION 5. That Chapter 8.20, Section 8.20.10 (a) of the Bentonville Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:

(a) The Traffic Safety and Signage Committee, subject to approval by the City Council, may from time to time, designate streets or portions thereof, or other streets, where the parking of vehicles is prohibited, limited or restricted on a permanent or long-term basis, and it shall be the duty of the Traffic Safety and Signage Committee to indicate such areas by appropriate markings or signs giving notice of the prohibition, limitation, or restriction. The placement of signs prohibiting, limiting or restricting parking on a temporary or short-term basis, shall be handled by the Chief of Police in accordance with Title 8, Vehicles and Traffic, Chapter 8.24, Parking Section 8.24.13 of the Bentonville Municipal Code.

SECTION 6. That Title 8, Vehicles and Traffic, Chapter 8.24, Parking, Section 8.24.13 of the Bentonville Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:

Signs: The Chief of Police or any other person authorized by the Mayor and Council shall cause signs to be posted in all areas where parking is limited or prohibited on a temporary or short-term basis, indicating such limitations or prohibitions. Permanent or long-term prohibitions or limitations on parking shall be handled by the Traffic Safety and Signage Committee in accordance with Chapter 8.20 of the Bentonville Municipal Code.

SECTION 7. That this ordinance is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Bentonville, Arkansas. An emergency is therefore declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

Section 1: That section 8.20.01 (b) of the Bentonville Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:

The Committee shall consist of the following members:

1. One Member of the City Council;
2. The Chief of Police or his designee;
3. The Community Development Director or his designee;
4. The City Transportation Engineer;
5. The City Street Manager;
6. The Street Sign Shop Technician;
7. The Assistant Fire Chief;
8. The Staff Attorney;
9. **The Parks and Recreation Director;**
10. The Mayor shall be an *ex officio* member of the Committee.
