2. **Traffic Calming Request - SE 2nd & B Streets** **Informational**

Our concerns have increased about safety for both cars and people over this last year at the intersection of SE 2nd and B Street. Our request is for No Parking signage to be placed in front of our home at 207 SE 2nd Street to provide clearance for fire trucks and vehicles to pass, which is increasingly difficult if cars are parked end to end in the street in front of our home. Also, our gutter system is well maintained but takes a beating when vehicles swing out of lane and slide onto the gutter. At present we are again repairing recent damage.

As a good citizen for 30 plus years we are asking for this consideration for a safe flow of traffic at this intersection.

Cindy Acree made a motion to approve temporary signage (to be installed by the Police Department) until construction is complete in the area. Seconded by Chief Justin Scantlin. Voice vote, motion approved.

3. **Signage and Street Markings Request** **Informational**

The applicant attended the Active Transportation Advisory Board last month. During the meeting, the board voted to support efforts to improve safety at the junction of NW A Street and NW Leopard Lane.

Proposal:

1. Repaint Double Yellow Lines that have eroded on NW A street near the junction of NW Leopard Lane
2. Add two stop signs on NW A Street at the junction of NW Leopard Lane to create a 3 way stop
3. Reduce the speed limit in the area from 30mph to 20 mph

Committee reviewed each proposed item:

Item #1 to update striping of double yellow lines: Motion made by Cindy Acree to approve the request based on City Funds. The Street Department will review and schedule maintenance. Seconded by David Bailey. Voice vote, motion approved.

Items #2 of the 3-way stop signs request & Item #3 of reduced speed limit request, Daniel Clardy motion made to table until a full review of the area can be conducted & studied. Will be brought back to the Committee once the Street/Transportation Department recommendations are complete. Seconded by Cindy Acree. Voice vote, motion approved.
