New Business

Non-Motorist Crash Report Review

Josh Stacey reported that Sargent Josh Holland was unable to attend but provided crash reports and mapping data, which will be distributed once finalized. The following was discussed:

- Bicycle crash involving a child near Creekside Middle School and the potential absence of school zone signage on Featherston Road
- Vegetation and tree maintenance impacting visibility near Walton Boulevard and commercial driveways
- Citation issued to a cyclist at a crosswalk
- Unresolved hit-and-run incident involving a cyclist
- Multiple aggressive driving incidents involving cyclists and pedestrians
- Members requested follow-up information from Bentonville Police Department representatives
- It was also agreed to investigate near-miss reporting options, including use of the 311 system or a dedicated reporting application
- Members noted several incidents along I Street and discussed the need for location-specific crash analysis

Capital Projects Update

Bright Road Side Path

- Trail substantially complete
- Final intersection work expected shortly
- Ribbon-cutting event postponed and to be rescheduled

Ridgeback Greenway (High School to 14th Street)

- Trail nearing completion
- Tunnel construction remains underway and is expected to open later in the year

Wishing Spring Trail

- Construction is progressing
- Completion anticipated in October 2026

Applegate Connection through Gateway Park

- East Park opening anticipated in July 2026
- West Park and skate park anticipated in August 2026
- Gateway Park completion expected in November 2026

Bicycle Infrastructure Discussion

- Use and education of bicycle boxes at intersections.

- Public awareness and educational efforts regarding bicycle infrastructure
- Opportunities for improved connectivity along Third Street
- Safety concerns involving youth use of e-bikes and mini-bikes
- Potential school partnerships and safety education programs

Future Budget Planning

Josh Stacey requested recommendations for Fiscal Year 2027 budget priorities from board members

Suggested focus areas included:

- Wayfinding improvements
- Intersection safety enhancements
- School zone safety improvements
- Small-scale infrastructure projects that improve network connectivity
- Trail and bicycle network gap closures
